

EXHIBICIÓN / EXHIBITION: ÁLVARO ZARDONI & JEAN-GABRIEL LAMBERT

Alvaro Zardoni incursiona en la escultura de manera independiente, experimentando con diferentes materiales hasta llegar al uso casi exclusivo del bronce en su obra actual. Su escultura, figurativa y de pequeño formato, se ve acompañada usualmente de diversos objetos encontrados que van reforzando el concepto que les dio origen.

Hay siempre una carga psicológica y emotiva en cada una de sus piezas. Su temática de corte clásico hace referencia a contenidos mitológicos, personajes literarios o legendarios. Expone regularmente en diversas galerías, espacios oficiales, centros culturales y sitios alternativos de México y los Estados Unidos. Es arquitecto egresado de la Universidad Anáhuac (1987). Es miembro del Salón de la Plástica Mexicana a partir de febrero de 2006.

Anteriormente un actor, Jean-Gabriel Lambert, comenzó a pintar hace 15 años. Este pintor canadiense empezó su carrera como artista dibujando, su primera serie incluía una historia. En esos tiempos, su obra consistía principalmente de los colores negro, blanco y azul - su color favorito. Después estudió pintura en acuarela y acrílico, convirtiéndose, este último, en su pasión. Después de sólo tres años como pintor tuvo una exhibición en Montreal. Lambert se enamora de México durante su primera visita a Vallarta en 1999 y por primera vez agregó el color amarillo a su obra. Siguió siendo inspirado por la luz, color y la gente de Vallarta. El rumbo artístico en el que embarcó hace 25 años lo ha llevado alrededor del mundo buscando inspiración. Últimamente su destino preferido es México, Puerto Vallarta en particular. Ahora pinta aquí cada año durante su visita. Aunque también pinta en su estudio en Montreal.

Es un artista canadiense contemporáneo que ha hecho de Puerto Vallarta su hogar durante el invierno. Durante la temporada se puede encontrar pintando en el jardín de Galleria Dante.

Ambos artistas estarán exhibiendo su obra a partir del 11 de marzo a las 6:00pm en el espacio que ocupa Galleria Dante, en la Zona Romántica de Puerto Vallarta. ■

Alvaro Zardoni delved into independent sculpture, experimenting with various materials to finally arrive at the almost exclusive use of bronze in his current work. His sculpture, figurative and small form, is usually accompanied by various found objects that reinforce the concept that originated them. There is always a psychological and emotional burden in each of the elements. His themes of classical mythology refer to content, either literary or legendary characters. He exhibits regularly in galleries, official spaces, cultural centers and alternative sites throughout Mexico and the United States. He graduated from the Universidad Anahuac as an architect (1987). He has been a member of the Mexican Arts Salon since February 2006.

Formerly an actor, Jean-Gabriel Lambert, began painting 15 years ago. This Canadian painter began his career as a sketch artist; his first series included a story. At that time, his work consisted mainly of black, white and blue, his favorite color. Then he studied painting in watercolor and acrylic; in his passion becoming the latter. After only three years as an artist he held an exhibition in Montreal. Lambert fell in love with Mexico during his first visit to Puerto Vallarta in 1999 and for the first time he added the color yellow to his work. He continued to be inspired by the light, color and people of Vallarta. The artistic direction in which he embarked 25 years ago has sent him looking for inspiration around the world. Lately his favorite destination is Mexico, Puerto Vallarta in particular. He now paints here every year during his visit. But he also paints in his studio in Montreal.

Lambert is a contemporary Canadian artist who has made Puerto Vallarta his home during the winter. During the season, he can be found painting in the gardens of Galleria Dante.

Both these artists will be exhibiting their work beginning March 11 at 6:00pm at Galleria Dante in the Romantic Zone of Puerto Vallarta. ■
